

The Shinsei Martial Arts Scholarship

This scholarship may cover tuition, uniform and equipment for qualified students at Shinsei Martial Arts & Fitness Center.

Tuition will be provided on a sliding scale up to a fully paid scholarship for qualifying students.

To qualify, students must show a financial need base on income and number of person in a household. The sliding scale is attached to this scholarship. Also, some students may qualify on a temporary basis if there is a temporary hardship such as a loss of income by adult family member.

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of:

- a) Recommendation of the dojo owner verifying student initiative, interest, attendance, and worthiness.
- b) Financial need, as established on Part 2 of the Scholarship Application Form. All requested documentation (prior year Form 1040 tax return, most recent month of pay stubs, copy of Benefits Determination Letter, etc) must be submitted with application.
- c) Completed application with accompanying letter from applicant. If possible provide a letter from dojo owner, and community member (when applicable).

To qualify family must meet all listed below:

- Agree to attend classes at least twice a week (ages 7 and up)
- Adhere to code of conduct
- Participate in Shinsei's community service programs
- Promise to do their best at home and at school including being respectful, cooperating, doing satisfactory work, and receiving passing grades.
- No illegal activity
- Have a financial hardship, learning, or physical disability.
- Mandatory - Parent Involvement Hours (PIP)

Code of Conduct

1. Address all Adults as Sir or Ma'am
2. Bow respectfully when entering the workout area
3. Accept correction from you teachers and parents respectfully
4. Obey your conscience, not your mind
5. Be loyal to your friends
6. Honor your country
7. Be truthful
8. Conduct yourself in a proper manner at all times
9. Profanity or abusive language is not allowed and will not be tolerated
10. Starting fights outside of Karate or the misuse of your teachings in any way
11. Criminal activity will be cause for termination of membership
12. No alcohol consumption before class
- 13.No Bullying: No physical or verbal abuse of others will be tolerated

A student may be suspended by Shinsei Martial Arts pending a hearing on their disciplinary issue. Serious disciplinary issues will be addressed by a board of no less than three and no more than five Shinsei admin. Disciplinary board must include at least one sensei level black belt. One black belt position on the board can be substituted with a non-black belt member of the Karate for all board of directors. Their decision will be final in all disciplinary matters.

Amount of these scholarships shall be determined by the deciding board. Duration of the scholarships will be for the length of 6 months at which time they can be re-evaluated. At the time of re-evaluation, the student must be actively participating in one of the Shinsei programs. Attendance to be verified quarterly by submission of attendance cards by the dojo owner and the progression of student rank. Financial need will be reviewed semi-annually to determine continuation of scholarship.

Mandatory - Parent Involvement Hours (PIP)

Each family must contribute **at least 8 hours of service per month**, for each month the scholarship is in effect. We hope you will consider this a minimum commitment and not a target. We have several exciting volunteer opportunities for you so that you can be involved in your or your child's martial arts training here at Shinsei - just don't forget to sign up early when the opportunities become available! Failure to fulfill the required hours will be treated as non-payment and therefore will result in the removal from the program.
